Look what Jesus did for us:		
Romans 5:8, "Christ d for us.		
Isaiah 53:5, "But he was w for our		
transgressions, he was b for our iniquities: the		
chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are		
healed."		
Matthew 27:29, "And when they had platted (made) a		
c of t , they put it upon his		
head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the		
knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!"		
Matthew 27:30, "And they $s$ upon him, and took the		
reed, and s him on the head."		
Matthew 27:35, "And they c him,"		
That means we hung Christ on a cross.		
I Corinthians 15:4, "And that he (Jesus) was b ,		
and that he $r$ again the third day according to the		
scriptures:" This means Jesus became alive again after He died on		
the cross. Only God can do that! Jesus proved He is God.

did not deserve it, we just receive it just like a gift at Christmas time.

Here is how we receive Christ: by calling on Jesus Christ to save us and by believing on Him with all of our heart.

Romans 10:13, "For whosoever shall c\_\_ \_ upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Here's what you tell Jesus when you call on the Lord.



- 1. Admit that you are a sinner and do bad things.
- 2. Thank Christ for dying for you and paying your punishment. Believe that He rose from the dead.
- 3. Ask Him to come into your heart and save you.

(That is what receiving Christ means.)

You can do that anywhere, at anytime. If you have not received him, do it now! Once you have received Christ into your heart he will never leave you.

Hebrews 13:5, "I will n\_\_\_\_ leave thee, nor forsake thee." Once you have been saved, Jesus will never leave you and never forget about you. John 10:28, "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any m\_\_\_\_ pluck them out of my hand."

God keeps us saved. If good works, going to church and being good can not save us, it can not keep us saved either. God saves us and keeps us. Now as a child of God, we must be good, obedient children, and follow God's plan and commands.
