
Wall of Letters



To unscramble the message in the wall of letters, writing left to right only use the letters in the odd-numbered columns (1,3,5...) the first time through.


On the second try, use only the letters in the even-numbered columns (2,4,6...).

What does the Bible say? Here are some questions we will try to answer.



3. He had a part in the birth of Jesus - Luke 1:35, "And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall c upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be b of thee shall be called the Son of God."
4. He raised Jesus from the dead - Romans 8:11b, "He that r up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you."
5. He convicts us of sin and things we do wrong - John 16:8
6. He seals our salvation with eternal life - Ephesians 1:13
7. He prays on our behalf - Romans 8:27
8. He comforts us when bad things happen - John 14:16, "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another C, that he may abide with you for ever;"
9. He gives us power to tell others about Christ - Acts 1:8, "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come u you: and ye shall be w unto me"
10. He shows us how to live right. <i>Galatians 5:22 - 23, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, g, faith, Meekness, temperance:"</i>
11. He gives gifts and talents to serve the Lord with - I Corinthians 12:11
