


ABC's of the Christian Life for Youth

Let's first look at what a few words in our theme verse mean. ⇒ **Rebellion** is not obeying those who have authority over us (parents, teachers, police, etc.) ⇒ Witchcraft is worshipping the devil. ⇒**Stubbornness** is not changing the way we think even if we are wrong. \Rightarrow **Iniquity** is another word for sin. ⇒**Idolatry** is worshipping anyone other than God. God said in the Bible that rebellion and stubbornness is just as bad as worshipping the devil and idols! Why does God hate rebellion? **1. Because God set up the authority.** Romans 13:1, "Let every soul be s____ unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God." Here are some authorities God has set up: - His Word, the Bible is the highest authority. Matthew 4:4, "But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the m____ of G___." - Kings & rulers - Nehemiah 9:37, "...unto the k____ whom thou hast set over us..." - Apostles or missionaries around the world - Ephesians 4:11 - Prophets or preachers - Ephesians 4:11 - **P** of churches - *Ephesians 4:11* - **T**__ _ _ _ - Ephesians 4:11 - Parents - Ephesians 6:1, "Children, o_____ your parents in the Lord: for this is right." - Higher powers that are set up by the government to punish
