## Christian A merica

In the late 19th century, Captain Alfred Thayer Mahan, United States Navy, responsible for developing the doctrine of the projection of U.S. Naval sea power, wrote books that were studied by every class in Annapolis. This is what he said about another Book: "Upon the Bible my life rests for whatsoever is good and strong...Christ is to me one who speaks with authority no less than Divine, to whom I submit where I do not understand."

Webster's dictionary and his History of the United States were not the only books that Noah Webster authored. His famous "bluebacked speller" sold an incredible million copies a year--for one hundred years! In one of his early editions appeared a Moral Catechism--rules for moral conduct in which Webster stated: "God's Word, contained in the Bible, has furnished all necessary rules to direct our conduct."

On Sept. 07, 1864 a deputation of blacks from Baltimore presented the 16th President with a Bible. In thanking them Lincoln said: "In regard to this Great Book, I have but to say, it is the best gift God has given to man. All the good Saviour gave to the world was communicated through this book. But for it, we could not know right from wrong. All things most desirable for man's welfare, here and hereafter, are to be found portrayed in it. To you I return my most sincere thanks for the elegant copy of the great Book of God which you present."
