

"Thank you for giving up some of your time during this season of festivals. This year has been the best year yet. We had 21 consecutive Saturdays of festivals, carnivals, parks and fairs. There were over 23 different fairs and festivals and a combined 274 people attending (some only came once while others came every week). This year we handed out over 32,150 tracts with around 10 saved. With the combination of 3,000 tracts at the Eden Parade and 22,500 smiles at the Dunkirk and Erie County Fair, over 57,650 tracts were given out by the church (and 323 saved at the fairs).
