December 10 - Sunday - **Pastor Tom Stiles** from Freedom’s Alert will speak in 5:30 and 6:30 services.

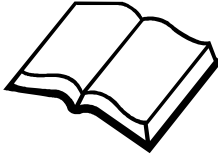
