## Let's "Change" the World Through Missions

Our change weigh-in will be held on Thanksgiving Eve during the service. Bring in all of your spare change for missions. This year our challenge is to out-weigh Pastor. That will take about 175 lbs of change. Pastor will throw an ice cream party on November 25 if we reach our goal.

### Since Last Thanksgiving...

- 1. Your heart has beat 40,000,000 times. (That is 109,589 times each day, 4,566 times per hour, and 75 times per minute.)

  The Heart pumps blood through 1000's of miles of arteries every minute. The blood makes the trip throughout your body every 23 seconds. That is 3,756
- 2. Your eyelids have blinked 4.2 million times. (That's 11,507 times per day, 719 times each hour you were awake, and 12 times per minute.)
- 3. Your lungs took between 6,289,920 and 10,483,200 breaths depending on a rate of 12-20 breaths per minute. (at 12 bpm that's about 17,000 per day and 121,000 per week! At 20 bpm that is about 28,000 and 202,000 per week.)

Question: How many miles does the Earth travel in space each day?

Answer: The first and simple answer is found by calculating the circumference of the Earth's orbit around the sun and dividing by the number of day in a year.

The average distance from the sun to the Earth is 150 million kilometers of 93.2 million miles. Multiplying by 2 Pi gives 585.6

miles for the circumference. Dividing this by 365.25 days per year gives 1.0603 million miles per day. The actual average orbital velocity is closer to 18.5 miles per second, accounting for the fact that the orbit is slightly elliptical. Using this value gives a more accurate 1.598 million miles per day average.
