About our Special Speaker

for the 25th Anniversary Service, April 6, 2008

Dr. Shelton Smith was born on December 4, 1942. He received the Lord as his personal Savior in September of 1951. After listening to his pastor preach as a 14-year-old boy he walked down the aisle of the church during the invitation and told his pastor he was called to preach. The pastor stopped the service and addressed the congregation, "If that be the case, then you will preach next Sunday", and he did. The first ones down the aisle after his sermon were his mom and dad. They have been members of that same church for the past 51 years.

In Bible College and Seminary he graduated Summa Cum Laude and finished in the top 3% of his class in Greek and Hebrew. He holds a Bachelors, Masters, and two earned Doctorate degrees in history, education, and theology.

He founded the Open Door Baptist Church of Ventura, California and later moved to become the Pastor of the Church of the Open Door (Independent Baptist) in Westminster, Maryland. The church there grew from less than 200 in attendance to an average of 1500 per Sunday with many days exceeding 2000. Hundreds were saved and baptized each year and the membership roll grew to over 3000.

Dr. Smith has been married to Betty Elaine for over 45 years. They have two children who assist him at the Sword of the Lord Publications in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. He became the editor of this newspaper in 1995. The Sword of the Lord has been the most widely circulated Christian newspaper since 1934. He has also written 28 books and published numerous articles and news reports.
