In my youth, science was more important to me than either man or God. I worshipped science. Its advancement had surpassed man's wildest dreams. It took many years for me to discover that science with all its brilliance, lights only a middle chapter of creation.



I saw the aircraft I love destroying the civilization I expected it to save. Now I understand that spiritual truth is more essential to a nation that the mortar in its cities' walls. For when the actions of a people are undergirded by spiritual truths there is safety. When spiritual truths are rejected, it is only a matter of time before civilization will collapse.

We must understand spiritual truths and apply them to our modern life. We must draw strength from the almost forgotten virtues of simplicity, humility, contemplation and prayer.
