1. The Sinner

All are sinners. A sinner is someone who Jesus has paid our sentence for us! has committed a crime, small or large, against God's holiness and commandments.

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" (Romans 3:23)

"For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not." (Ecclesiastes 7:20)

2. The Sentence
