### WORLD RELIGIONS & "WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?"

How do other religions answer the cry of the Philippian jailer, "What must I do to be saved?" (Acts 16:30)

The Muslim replies:

"Repeat the words, 'There is no God but Allah, and Mohamet is his prophet', pray five times a day; give alms to beggars; keep the fasts; read the Koran; and make a pilgrimage to Mecca."

The Hindu replies:

"Observe the rules of the caste; worship the monkey and the cow; crawl through the dust like a measuring worm to the sacred temple; bathe in the waters of the Ganges; erect a temple to one of the million divinities. You may escape rebirth as a reptile or a beast or a woman and become absorbed in the deity."

The Buddhist replies:

"Forget that you have a body; become indifferent to the pleasure and pain. You may attain to Nirvana - the state of the extinguished flame."

The Confucian scholar replies:

"Study the sacred classics, and learn the rules of righteousness. Confucius shows the path of duty but cannot help you follow it. You must save yourself.

Contrast these with the simple, all-sufficient answer of Paul: "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved." (Acts 16:31) There is no requirement to understand the deep questions of theology or to perform impossible tasks. You cannot save yourself; Christ will save you.

### Who was Titus Coan?

Missionary to Hawaii, Coan began his missionary trek in 1822, when he sailed to Patagonia, a barren region of South America in Argentina and Chile between the Andes Mountains and the Atlantic Ocean. His main burden, however, was for the people of Hawaii, who he served for almost 50 years (1835-1882), with only a brief visit to the States (1872-1872). Coan was fluent in the native dialects and preached with mighty power which resulted in great revivals. He recieved 7,832 into his church in the city of Hilo on Hawaii, the largest of the islands. By 1860, his church included 11,960 members. Coan was first married for Fidelia Church on November 3, 1834 (died in 1872), then to Lydia Bingham in 1873. He was converted in a Finney revival in Western New York.

May the good Lord raise up others from Western New York to do great works for God. Pray the Lord of the harvest, for the laborers are few.
