Elisha got sick and died like everyone else even though he was such a great man of God. Sickness has no respect of persons. Some Biblical reasons for why there is sickness include:

- 3. Satanic Affliction Job 2:7; Luke 13:10-17
- 4. Poor Diet Proverbs 23:3; Psalm 141:4; Daniel 1:8,15
- 5. Risky Behavior Romans 1:27
- 6. Trials of our Faith and Spiritual Warfare Philippians 2:25-30

Humbly consider why you might be weak or sickly. Is there a spiritual reason for the sickness? Don't forget to pray to God, our merciful healer, when you are afflicted. James 5:13-16
