Martin Luther's Method

Martin Luther said, "I study my Bible as I gather apples. First I shake the whole tree that the ripest might fall. Then I shake each limb, and when I have shaken each limb, I shake each branch and every twig. Then I look under every leaf.

"I search the Bible as a whole, like shaking the whole tree. Then I shake every limb - study book after book. Then is shake every branch, giving attention to the chapters when they do not break the sense. Then I shake every twig, or a careful study of the paragraphs, sentences, words and their meanings.
