In 1842, Sir Richard Owen coined the word dinosaur, meaning "terrible lizard," after discovering large reptilian-like fossils.

However in the book of Job, written 4,000 years earlier, God describes behemoth as: the largest of all land creatures, plant eating (herbivores), with great strength in its hips and legs, powerful stomach muscles, a tail like a cedar tree, and bones like bars of iron. This is an accurate description of sauropods - the largest known dinosaur family.
