5 PLACES WHERE THE FLAG FLIES AT NIGHT

The U.S. Flag is flown night and day at only five places in the nation, and the practice dates only from 1898, flag experts say.



The places are: the grave of Francis Scott Key at Frederick, MD; Fort McHenry and Flag House in Baltimore; The Capitol Building in Washington; and the War Memorial in Worcester, Mass.

The practice resulted from public pressure, not from government action, when it began at Frederick in 1898. Since Key was the author of the "Star Spangled Banner," it seemed appropriate that over his tomb there should be: "Proof through the night that our flag was still there."

When Hudson Taylor went to China, he made the voyage on a sailing vessel. As it neared the channel between the southern Malay Peninsula and the island of Sumatra, the missionary heard an urgent knock on his stateroom door. He opened it, and there stood the captain of the ship. "Mr Taylor," he said, "we have no wind. We are drifting toward an island where the people are heathen, and I fear they are cannibals." "What can I do?" asked Taylor.

"I understand you believe in God. I want you to pray for wind."

"All right, Captain, I will, but you must set the sail."
"Why, that's ridiculous! There's not even the slightest breeze. Besides, the sailors will think I'm crazy."
But finally, because of Taylor's insistence, he agreed. Forty-five minutes later he returned and found the missionary still on his knees. "You can stop praying now," said the captain. "We've got more wind than we know what to do with!"
