The **King James Bible**contrasted with the New International Version

In Luke 2:33 the Bible reads, "And JOSEPH and his mother marveled at those things which were spoken of him."

The NIV reads, "The CHILD'S FATHER and mother marveled at what was said about him."

The child's father? Was Joseph Jesus' father? No, or Jesus would have been a sinner just like us (Romans 5:12). Jesus was born of a virgin without the seed of a man.

His miraculous birth was an act of God, not of Joseph. Jesus is the only "begotten" son of God (John 3:16). If Joseph were His father, He could not save us.

The Greek word for Joseph (Ioseph) cannot possibly be confused with the Greek word for father (pater). The translators of the NIV must have made this change intentionally. That's wrong.

It is true that many are praying for worldwide revival. But it would be more timely, and more scriptural, for prayer to be made to the Lord of the harvest, that He would raise up and thrust forth laborers who would fearlessly and faithfully preach those truths which are calculated to bring about revival."
