THE BUSY BEE

To produce one pound of honey, a bee must visit **56,000 clover heads**.

Since each clover head has 60 flower tubes, a total of **3,360,000 visits** are necessary to give us that pound of honey for the breakfast table.

Meanwhile, that worker bee has flown the equivalent of **three times** around the world.

To produce one tablespoon of honey for our toast, the little bee makes **4,200 trips** to flowers.

He makes about **10 trips a day**, each an average of 20 minutes, taking him to 400 flowers. A worker bee will fly as far as **eight miles** if he cannot find a closer nectar flow.

When you feel that persistence is a difficult task, think of the bee.
