SINCE YOU ARE GOING

In Matthew 28:19, "Go" is often translated as an imperative form of the verb. In reality, the word form is a participle, meaning "going" or "as you go."

The meaning is like a wife speaking to her husband who is on his way to the store. She does not say, "Go to the store and get me a spool of thread." He is already going to the store. So she says, "Since you are going to the store, will you bring me a spool of thread?"

Thus Jesus said, "Since you are going." He never for one moment entertained the idea that with such a glorious message of salvation, His friends would not go and share it. We certainly should do no less!

When a young minister asked the Duke of Wellington whether he did not consider it useless to attempt to evangelize India, the Iron Duke sternly replied: "What are your marching orders, sir?"

WORD OF A GENTLEMAN

When David Livingstone sailed for Africa the first time, a group of his friends accompanied him to the pier to wish him bon voyage. Some of them, concerned for the safety of the missionary, reminded him of the dangers which would confront him in the far land to which he was journeying. In fact, one man urged Livingstone to remain in England.

In response, David Livingstone opened his Bible and read aloud the portion of our Lord's last recorded words in Matthew 28: "Lo, I am with you alway." Turning to the one who would have prevented his going, the missionary said: "That, my friend, is the word of a Gentleman. So let us be going."
