HENRY MARTYN Missionary & Bible Translator

One of the great names in missions is Henry Martyn (781-1812). He was an English missionary to India and what was then called Persia. When he arrived in Calcutta in April, 1806 he made the statement, "Now let me burn out for God!" Little did he know how fast he would burn out for God. Only six years later, he became ill with fever and died. He was buried by strangers and unbelievers at Tocat, Turkey. However, Martyn compressed a lifetime of service into those six short years. Let me share with you a statement by Henry Martyn.

He said, "The Spirit of Christ is the spirit of missions, and the nearer we get to him, the more intensely missionary we must become." The closer we get to God, the more we will care about missions. Why? God loves the world. The great passion of His heart is saving people. Therefore, the closer we get to Him the more we understand what He cares about.
