**Signer #5:** Samuel Adams (1722-1803) Massachusetts

Married twice: both named Elizabeth, both died before him. 6 children. Occupation: Merchant, Politician (wanted to be a minister)

"Neither the wisest constitution nor the wisest laws will secure the liberty and happiness of a people whose manners are universally corrupt."

"Let ministers and philosophers, statesmen and patriots, unite their endeavors to renovate the age by impressing the minds of men with the importance of educating their little boys and girls - of inculcating in the minds of youth, the love of their country; of instructing them in the art of self-government...and in short, of leading them in the study and practice of the exalted virtues of the Christian system."

Mr Adams was a Christian. His mind was early imbued with piety, as well as cultivated by science. He early approached the table of the Lord Jesus, and the purity of his life witness the sincerity of his profession. On the Christian Sabbath, he constantly went to the temple, and the morning and evening devotions in his family proved, that his religion attended him in his seasons of retirement from the world. The last productions of his pen was in favor of the Christian truth. He died in the faith of the gospel.
