Had a stroke, so his signature is hard to read. While signing he said, "My hand trembles but my heart does not."

His house was the resort of ministers, elders, and other members engaged in religious visits; and the usual place of meeting in Providence. The general religious meetings of the church were, in the winter season, frequently held at his dwelling.

In July, 1785 he acquired a lingering fever. He retained full possession of his faculties, and remained tranquil in spirit until his death on July 19. Inscribed on his tombstone are the following words: "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord; they rest from their labors, and their works do follow them." Rev 14:13
