Governor Huntington lived the life of the irreproachable and sincere Christian, and those who knew him most intimately, loved him the most affectionately. He was a thoughtful man, and talked but little - the expression of his mind and heart was put forth in his actions. Hence as a devoted Christian and a true patriot, he never swerved from duty, or looked back after he had placed his hand to the work.

He was the friend of order and of religion, a member of the Christian church, and punctual in the devotions of the family... For many years a professor of religion, Mr Huntington appeared to enjoy to great satisfaction both in the doctrines and ordinances of the gospel; a constant attendant upon public worship, 'he was occasionally the people's mouth to God, when destitute of preaching.' As a professor of Christianity, and a supporter of its institutions, he was exemplary and devout: he manifested an unshaken faith in its doctrines, amid the distress of declining life, until debility of mind and body, produced by his last illness, rendered him incapable of social intercourse.
