Ouotes & Notes:

Hopkinson's musical talents were directed not only to satire but to psalms. In 1764 the vestry of Christ Church in Philadelphia thanked him for teaching the choir the art of psalmody. He later served as rector's warden. To Hopkinson has come the honor of being America's first native composer. His My Days Haven Been So Wondrous Free is considered to be the earliest piece of music by an American. As for his appearance, "His person was a little below the common size. His features were small, but extremely animated. His speech was quick, and all his motions seemed to partake of the unceasing activity and versatility of the powers of his mind." Francis Hopkinson was church music director and choir leader, and the editor of a 1767 hymnal - one of the first purely American hymnals. His work took the one-hundred-and-fifty Psalms and set them all to music.

The still waters of a mountain lake reflect the snow-



capped mountains around it.

But if a strong wind churns up the surface, the beautiful mirror image is destroyed. The image can only be seen when the lake is calm.

Likewise, we may have trusted Christ as our Savior, but if the frustrations of life unsettle our daily walk with the Lord, others will not be able to see Jesus reflected in our lives. He is there, but His image is distorted. We must yield our lives to the control and direction of the Holy Spirit. He calms our hearts in the midst of frustrating storms that would disturb our reflection of Christ if we allow them to.

The Psalmist speaks of those who trust fully: "They cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses. He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven" (Psalm 107:28-30).
