Signer #22: Richard Stockton (1730-1781) New Jersey. Age at signing: 45 Married: Annis (6 children) Occupation: Lawyer

Quotes & Notes:

On the thirtieth of November 1776 (through 1778) he was unfortunately taken prisoner by a party of refugee royalists. He was dragged from his bed by night, and carried to New York. During his removal to the latter place he was treated with great indignity, and in New York he was placed in the common prison, where he was in want of even the necessities of life.

On top of all these discouragements, Stockton was stricken with cancer. He died in pain at his home near Princeton at the age of fifty, on February 28, 1781.

In his will, he set forth his faith that had sustained his life: "As my children . . . Will have frequent occasion of pursuing this instrument, and may probably be particularly impressed with the last words of their father, I think it proper here, not only to subscribe to the entire belief of the great and leading doctrines of the Christian religion, such as the being of a God, the universal defection and depravity of human nature, the divinity of the Person, and the completeness of the redemption purchased by the Blessed Savior; the necessity of the operations of the divine Spirit, of divine faith accompanied with an habitual virtuous life, and the universality of the divine providence; but also, in the bowels of a father's affection, to charge and exhort them to remember that 'the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom."
