Quotes & Notes:

No one knows exactly when James Smith was born, except that it was around 1719 in Ireland. His parents moved to America when he was 10 years old, and James attended a school in nearby Philadelphia that was taught by Pastor Francis Alison.

"In those early days in America, when congregations were not large enough to be able to pay their pastors an adequate salary, nor require all of a pastor's time, it was common for a minister to 'keep school.' In most communities, he was the best educated man and so the man best equipped for teaching."

James therefore learned proficiency in Latin and Greek. He also studied surveying, and the law at his brother's office in Lancaster. He is admitted to the bar when he was 26 and soon set up practice in York, where he was the only resident lawyer in town.
