Quotes & Notes:

Charles Caroll and Samuel Adams both cited religious freedom as the reason they became involved in the American Revolution.

Caroll was the only Catholic to sign the Declaration, and also was reputed to be the wealthiest man in America at the time. Yet he said in his own biography: "On the mercy of my Redeemer I rely for salvation and on His merits; not the works I have done in obedience to His precepts."

Not only was he the only Catholic to sign, but the only to designate his hometown "of Carollton."

The question arises, why did Mr. Caroll add the place of his residence? It is said that when he wrote his name, a delegate near him suggested that, as he had a cousin named Charles Caroll in Maryland, the latter might be taken for him, and he (the signer) escape attainder or any punishment that might fall upon the heads of the patriots. Mr. Caroll immediately seized the pen and wrote, "of Carrollton" at the end of his name, exclaiming, "They cannot mistake me now!"
