On January 27, 1796, George Washington commissioned Chase as an associate justice of the U.S. Supreme Court, in which position he remained for the rest of his life. Afflicted with severe gout, he died in Baltimore two months after celebrating his seventieth birthday.

Judge Chase was a man of great benevolence and in all his walks he exemplified the beauties of Christianity, of which he was a sincere professor.
