SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

Garter Braxton

Signer #40: Carter Braxton (1736-1797) Virginia. Age at signing: 39 Occupation: Planter, Merchant Married: Judith (2 children) Elizabeth (16 children!)

Quotes & Notes:

Braxton helped supply salt, uniforms, and blankets for the American forces, though the War brought Braxton many hardships. Some of his plantations and land holdings were ravaged by the British. His mansion, Chericoke, was destroyed by fire. At the beginning of the war, Braxton had heavily invested in shipping to carry American cargo to the other colonies, but the British captured most of his ships. His debt could only be collected in depreciated currency; therefore, he went deeper and deeper into debt, selling his plantation, mortgaging his furniture, and borrowing from relatives and friends. When he couldn't pay his debts, his estates were seized. Finally Braxton and his family were forced to move to Richmond in 1786, giving up the rich country life to which they were accustomed.
