SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

Signer #47: Joseph Hewes (1730 - 1779) North Carolina. Age at signing: 46 Occupation: Merchant.

Married: No, Isabella died just days before their wedding.

Quotes & Notes:

Hewes lived for just over three years after the signing. Illness forced him to leave Congress on October 29, 1779, and he died 12 days later at 49 years of age. It is believed that his death was caused by overwork and that he had sacrificed his health to help free his country. He is buried in Christ Church graveyard in Philadelphia.
