## Contenders for our Country SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

The May war to Jun.

**Signer #50:** Thomas Heyward (1746-1809) South Carolina. Age at signing: 30

**Occupation:** Lawyer

**Married:** Elizabeth (5 children) Suzanne (3 children)

### **Ouotes & Notes:**

Heyward joined the militia in 1779 as a captain of the artillery, in the same battalion with Edward Rutledge, another signer. He fought in several battles and suffered a gunshot wound at the Battle of Beaufort, which scarred him for life. He and Rutledge were both captured by the British during the fall of Charleston. They were imprisoned at St Augustine, Florida, in a prison reserved for rebels considered particularly dangerous. The British proceeded to plunder Heyward's plantation.

It was while imprisoned that he composed a song, "God Save the States," to the music of "God Save the King," and taught it to his fellow prisoners. It served to inspire the prisoners to new heights of patriotism.

After about a year in prison, Heyward and Rutledge were released in a prisoner exchange. On route to Philadelphia by ship, Heyward nearly lost his life when he fell overboard. He saved himself from drowning by hanging onto the ship's rudder until he was rescued. To add to his hardships, his wife died in his absence from home in 1782.
