Edward Rutledge and Thomas Lynch were the youngest signers of the Declaration. Both were 26.

Edward (Ned) returned home in late 1776 to help defend his state. He became a captain in an artillery battalion. When the British seized Charleston in the spring of 1780, Rutledge was among the first captives. He was imprisoned in St. Augustine, Florida, were "dangerous" rebels were held. He was released about a year later in a prisoner exchange.
