Genesis means *beginning*. Genesis is the book that tells about **the beginning of things**. It tells of the beginning of this world, the beginning of man, the beginning of sin, of civilization, of nations, of agriculture, of machinery, of music, of poetry.

It tells of the first marriage, the first child born, the first murder, the first drunkenness, the first kingdom, the first heathen temple; but most wonderful of all, it tells of the beginning of God's work of saving sinful man through the death of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.

The story of His death, beginning in Genesis, runs like a scarlet thread through the whole Bible. The seeds of all truth are in Genesis. The rest of the Bible unfolds them. The **main characters** of Genesis are Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph.

A Priest Accepted the Gift

One Sunday morning, a Roman Catholic Priest appeared before a congregation of a thousand persons in an Illinois town and said, "My people, I resign my priesthood," though he had been there thirty years.

At their earnest request he gave his reasons why he did so: "Last night I spent every hour praising God. All sleep had left me. After reading the New Testament I saw that salvation is in Jesus Christ, and is the gift of God's eternal love. Penance is not in it. Purgatory is not in it. Absolution is not in it. On my knees in my room I accepted the Gift, and I love the Giver, and I walked the room most of the night saying to myself: "I accept the Gift, and I love the Giver'."

And thus for an hour and a half "Father" Charles Chiniquy expounded to the people the grace of God. At the close of the sermon he asked how many of them would join with him in accepting the Gift and loving the Giver. Every man, woman, and child, except about forty, responded. And that is a Bible church today.
