What is the Book of Ezra about?

The book of Ezra belongs to a group of books dealing with the **history** of the Jewish people who lived in **Babylon** and some who **returned to Palestine**. The other books in this post-captivity group are Nehemiah, Esther, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi.

In 588 B.C., some years before the events recorded in the book of Ezra, a great foreign king, called **Nebuchadnezzar**, had swept through Palestine. He killed many people and carried the wise and wealthy of the children of Israel **back as captives** to his own land. Because the Lord's people had disobeyed and rejected Him, He allowed this severe punishment to come upon them—families were torn apart, homes were burned, and there was **great sorrow**.

The greatest tragedy was the **destruction** of the beautiful temple in Jerusalem. Now after **seventy years** of exile some of the Jews, by decree of **Cyrus the Great**, were allowed to return and, after many delays and trials, the temple was **rebuilt**. Later Ezra and his group of people came back to the land. And later still Nehemiah returned.
