What is the Book of Haggai about?

About **49,000 Israelites** had returned to Palestine after the seventy years' Babylonian captivity (see **Ezra and Nehemiah**, and their introductions), and God sent Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi to preach to them. This book contains Haggai's special message. which asked **how they could expect blessings** when the temple of the Lord was **still lying in ruins.**

Among many characteristics of the blind poetess Fanny Crosby, three stand out:

First, she always carried a little American flag. She either held it in her hand or kept it in her bag, and it was buried with her when she died at the age of 95.

Second, though she was blinded in infancy, Fanny greeted friends and strangers alike with a cheerful "God bless you dear soul."

Third, according to her own statement, she never attempted to write without first kneeling in prayer. If this be true, Fanny Crosby spent considerable time on her knees. She wrote no less than 8,000 songs.

Under contract for three hymns a week, Miss Crosby was often under pressure to meet deadlines. It was under such circumstances in 1869 that she tried to write words for a new tune. When words wouldn't come, she found she had forgotten to pray. Rising from prayer, she dictated—as fast as her assistant could write—words for "Jesus, Keep Me Near the Cross." (page #515 in our hymnal)

One day in 1874 Fanny Crosby prayed for more material things. She had run short of money and needed five dollars exactly. There was not time to draw on her publishers, so she simply prayed for the money. After praying, she walked to and fro in her room getting ready for another hymn when an admirer called. The two chatted briefly, and in the parting handshake the admirer left something in the her hand. It was five dollars—even change. Rising from a prayer of thanks the blind poetess wrote "All The Way My Saviour Leads Me" (see in the next column)

Though my weary steps may falter, and my soul athirst may be, gushing from the Rock before me, Lo! A spring of joy I see.

All the way my Savior leads me; oh, the fullness of His love! Perfect rest to me is promised in my Father's house above. When my spirit, clothed immortal, wings its flight to realms of day, this my song thro' endless ages; Jesus led me all the way.
