### What is 2 Corinthians About?

It is agreed that Paul wrote this second letter, probably at Philippi, to the Corinthians as an apologist. This does not mean that he had something for which to apologize! Certain charges had been brought against him, and he **defended himself** in these answers. His apology, in this sense, was a defense of his ministry and of himself as a servant of the Lord. This epistle shows that God was his Defense and **Comforter** amid all the unkind attacks that were made upon his character and conduct.

The letter does not divide easily into sections, but it may be roughly outlines as follows:

> **Explanation** – 2 Corinthians 1:1-7:16 **Exhortation** – 2 Corinthians 8:1-9:15 Vindication - 2 Corinthians 10:1-13:14
