3.) First-Hand Knowledge is Best

World Population 1950—2.5 Billion | Missionaries out of America—100,000 World Population 2024—8.0 Billion | Missionaries out of America—30,000 Churches closed during Covid—10,000

That's about 60 churches each year in each state for 3 years.

"Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;" - 2 Thessalonians 2:3

"Falling way" means apostasy (the rejection of Christianity by those who have been brought up in in)
